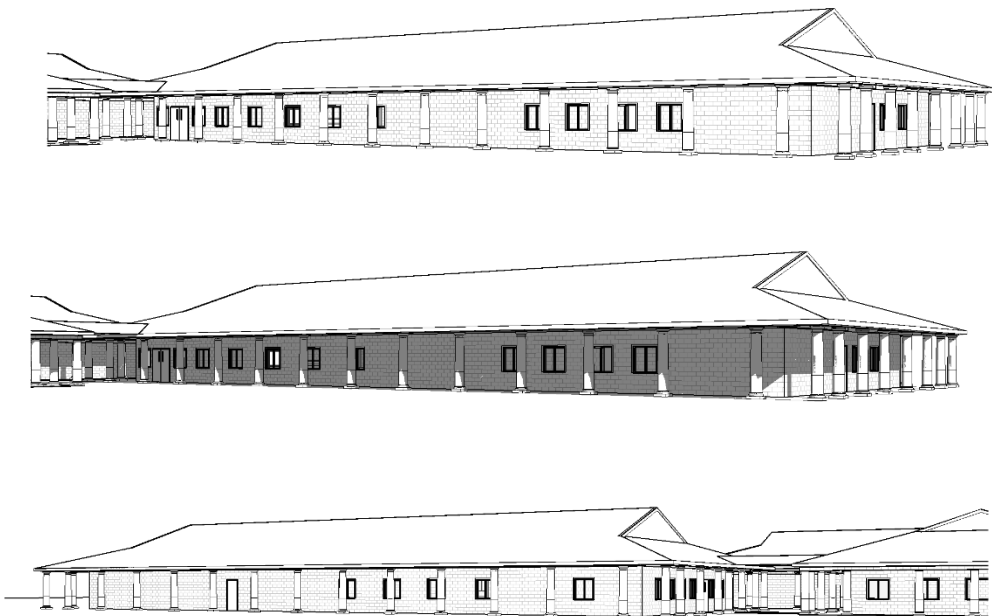


TPI IMM Q1, 2, and 3 Report

There wasn't much to report regarding the activities in Ghana in the first and second quarters this year. Since the beginning of July, however, much has happened.

- Reverend Stephen Fokuoh, the Director of the Ghana Baptist Health Services, retired and a new Director was appointed. His name is Frank Baffour.
- Also, in early July, I met with Don Highlander, the architect from Connecting Spaces in Hudson, OH who has been helping with the design of all the major buildings at the Nzema Hospital. He presented a preliminary diagram of the surgical suite that constitutes phase 3 of the construction at the hospital. I submitted a copy of this plan to Mike at that time.
- In early August, I traveled to Ghana to attend a retirement celebration for Reverend Stephen and to discuss the proposed plan for the surgical suite. While there, we were able to set up a video conference call with Don and made a few changes and additions to the plan.
- The revised plan is attached along with some 3D drawings of the exterior and interior. At this point, there are only a few minor details to resolve before construction can begin.
